SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 ILCA Class Rules will apply.
- 1.3 Under RRS 87, ILCA Dinghy Fundamental Class Rule Sail Identification will not apply.
- 1.4 US Sailing prescription Appendix U will apply.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

- 2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board(s) located on Clubspot.
- 2.2 Regatta Website URL: https://theclubspot.com/regatta/Uh7xCX1V0g

3 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0800 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it will take effect.
- 3.2 In accordance with RRS 90.2(c) changes to the sailing instructions may be made orally on the water. Failure to hear or receive on the water changes to the sailing instructions shall not be grounds for redress. The RC will signal a change and subsequent hail by using an attention signal as outlined in Appendix U2.

4 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 4.1 Date of racing: 10/11/2020
- 4.2 Number of races: No limit
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1100. This changes NOR 5.3.
- 4.4 No warning signal shall be made after 1500.

5 RACING AREAS

5.1 The racing area is Wayzata Bay on Lake Minnetonka.

6 THE COURSES

- 6.1 The diagrams in Attachment C show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 6.2 Courses shall not be shortened. This changes RRS 32.
- 6.3 Courses shall be L4 unless a change is hailed and preceded by its accompanying Appendix U2 sound signal. A change to the course shall be in effect for all races following the hailed/signaled change, or until another course change hail/signal replaces it.

7 MARKS

7.1 All marks will be orange, red, or white balls as shown in Attachment C.

8 THE START

- 8.1 Races will be started as follows: Appendix U. This changes RRS 26.
- 8.2 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the starting mark at the starboard end and the course side of the port-end starting mark.
- 8.3 All divisions/rigs will start together.

9 CHANGE OF THE NEXT LEG OF THE COURSE

- 9.1 To change the next leg of the course, the race committee will move the original mark (or the finishing line) to a new position.
- 9.2 Racing rule 33 is deleted in entirety and replaced as follows: "To maintain course configuration, or change length, marks may be moved as necessary, but no mark shall be moved when any boat is on the leg that it terminates. The mark must be in position before any boat begins sailing the changed leg. No change of course signals shall be made."

10 THE FINISH

10.1 The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the finishing boat at the port end and the course side of the starboard-end finishing mark.

11 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

- 11.1 There is no time limit.
- 11.2 Target time for races is 20 minutes.

12 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 12.1 All written protests must be filed electronically by emailing the required contents to matthew@wayzatasailing.org. No physical protest forms will be accepted.
- 12.2 The protest time limit is 30 minutes after the last boat has finished the last race of the day or the race committee signals no more racing today, whichever is later.
- 12.2 Notices will be posted to the online notice board no later than 10 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held, physically distanced, on the South Deck of the Mike Plant Community Boathouse.
- 12.4 The protest committee (PC) will be made up of one competitor of the protestor's choice, one competitor of the organizer's choice, and one competitor of the other two PC members' mutual agreement.
- 12.5 Competitors are encouraged to settle all protests on the water in accordance with RRS 44 to avoid increased risk of competitor exposure to COVID-19.

13 SCORING

- 13.1 The scoring system is as follows: RRS 90.3
- 13.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.3 (a) When 4 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total

of her race scores.

(b) When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 14.1 Check-in: All competitors shall complete check in before rigging to confirm their sail number, complete a health screening, and confirm adherence with venue rules. [DP]
- 14.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible. [DP]
- 14.3 Competitors shall comply with all venue rules outlined in NOR 7 and SI Attachment B. [DP]

15 SUPPORT BOATS

15.1 Team leaders, coaches, spectators, and other support persons shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the preparatory signal for the first start until all boats have finished or retired or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment. [DP]

16 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: whatever Zupon feels like, receives from Bruce, or buys. Competition is its own reward. If no races are completed, prizes shall still be given via the results of a socially distanced competition of Zupon's choosing which may include a (but will not be limited to): kinetics race, hide and go seek, greasy watermelon, shoe-batchi, or mast climbing.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death or illness sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.


