### WAYZATA YACHT CLUB (WYC) SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SI)

#### 1. RULES.

- 1.1 Races will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), except as changed by WYC Notice of Race (NOR) posted at www.wyc.org or this SI.
- 1.2 Class & Local Fleet Rules. Each boat will conform to their one-design/PHRF/MORC class rules, except as modified by this SI, the NOR or Official Special Fleet Rules. "Official Special Fleet Rules," posted at <a href="https://www.wyc.org">www.wyc.org</a>, will also apply only if posted online at least 1 week prior to applicable Cup race or series.
- 1.3 This SI will apply to all races conducted by WYC on Lake Minnetonka including Bob Slocum Memorial Family Fun Regatta, WYC Fall Regatta and Rumble One Day Regattas (Rumbles). **See Addendum A for additional rules applicable to Rumbles.**
- 1.4 This SI will <u>not</u> apply to Apostle Islands Station or other regattas held at or by WYC, which will be conducted pursuant to separate notices of race and sailing instructions
- **2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS.** Notices will be posted on WYC's Official Notice Board.
- **3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.** Any SI changed onshore will be posted at least 2 hours before the race where it takes effect. A change to the race schedule will be posted at least 2 hours before the race that precedes a change in the schedule. Race Committee (RC) may alter any SI on-the-water by hail after displaying code flag "L" with one sound in the racing area.
- **4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE.** Signals made ashore will be displayed from WYC's flagpole or RC boat at WYC docks. If a postponement is signaled ashore, warning signal will be made not less than 45 minutes after flag AP is lowered.
- **5. SCHEDULE OF RACES.** The schedule of races and warning signals are attached. Notwithstanding, a special heavy air race or light air race may be substituted for a scheduled race at the RC's discretion.
- **6. HEAVY AIR / LIGHT AIR RACES.** Flag "N" displayed ashore over flag "L" with three sounds means scheduled racing is cancelled and a heavy air race or light air race will be sailed with a warning announced by RC. Starting sequence will be announced by the RC. For the heavy air and light air races, no WYC prizes and no Boat-Of-The-Year (BOTY) points will be awarded.
- **7. CLASS FLAGS.** MORC and PHRF boats must conspicuously display a flag (of at least 9" x 9") at approximate eye level on its backstay or running backstay as follows: MORC I orange; MORC II blue; MORC III black; PHRF I green; and PHRF II Yellow.
- **8. RACING AREAS.** The racing areas are as shown in Illustration "A" attached.

#### 9. THE COURSES.

- 9.1 Location for each race is listed in attached Schedule of Races.
- 9.2 <u>Illustration "A"</u> shows Big Island course, Commodore Cup course and Burton Cup/MS Cup course. RC will specify on-the-water whether such courses will be sailed clockwise or counter-clockwise.
  - 9.2.1 Big Island course start and finish lines may be located anywhere around the islands.
  - 9.2.2 Commodore Cup course start and finish lines may be located anywhere in Wayzata Bay at discretion of RC, depending upon conditions or others use of the lake.
  - 9.2.3 Burton Cup/MS Cup follows the Commodore Cup course shown on <u>Illustration "A"</u>, except: (a) start/finish line is on main lake approx. northwest of MYC Lighthouse Island, and (b) buoy in Wayzata Bay is a rounding mark (i.e., the legs towards WYC are not used).
- 9.3 Other Races: Diagram in <u>Illustration "B"</u> shows various windward/leeward and triangle courses.

- 9.4 Diagram in <u>Illustration "C"</u> shows courses for various trapezoid courses. If there is no triangle course assigned to any fleet, then no RG mark will be set.
- 9.5 Diagram in <u>Illustration "D"</u> shows various windward/leeward courses with mid-leg *start* and *finish*.
- 9.6 Attached diagrams show the order and required side that marks are to be passed. Diagrams are illustrations only, including only the approximate angles between legs. <u>Actual distance and angles of legs (including placement of offset mark) for each race will be at discretion of RC.</u>

#### 10. MARKS.

- 10.1 Marks will be inflatables. In <u>Illustration "C"</u>, starting mark will be *Lime Green* (except as otherwise announced on-the-water by RC), and marks will be *orange* inflatables on the right (RW, RG and RL) and *yellow* inflatables on the left (LW and LL).
- 10.2 An offset mark may be set approximately adjacent to a windward mark. Offset mark is a mark of the course for all courses which must be rounded to port after rounding the windward mark.
- 10.3 When a mark is changed, the new mark may have a different shape and/or color.
- 10.4 All government navigation buoys are marks of the course and must be obeyed, except "SLOW" buoys at channels are <u>not</u> marks of the course.

#### 11. THE START.

- 11.1 Except Rumbles, starts will follow the sequences printed on the front page with the signals and timing shown. Except for boats in the first start, Preparatory & Start signals for a start are the Warning & Preparatory signals for boats in the next start. ".00" time on the front page corresponds to the time shown in the attached Schedule of Races. This instruction, and the chart on the front page, change RRS *Rule* 26.
- 11.2 Warning signal for first fleet will be a white flag.
- 11.3 Starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on an RC boat and course side of Mark L2. Mark L1 (gate mark, when used) may or may not be positioned before the start.
- 11.4 One minute 'round-an-end' rule described in RRS *Rule* 30.1 will <u>automatically</u> be in effect for all starts. Code Flag 'I' will not be displayed except as original preparatory signal. This modifies RRS *Rules* 26 and 30.1.
- 11.5 <u>Individual Recalls</u>: When signaling an individual recall, the RC may hail (and may announce *via* radio) the sail number(s) of boat(s) being recalled. Failure or delay to provide announcements will not be grounds for redress under RRS *Rule* 62.1(a).
- 11.6 <u>General Recalls</u>: A class recalled will go to the end of the start sequence and start 3 minutes after the last class (or previously recalled class) has started. 'First Substitute' will be lowered one minute before the next scheduled start and no sound signals will be made. This changes RRS *Rule* 29.2.

#### 12. THE FINISH.

- 12.1 Windward Finish: The finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a RC Boat and the course side of a nearby mark. A windward finish may be at a course side of a windward mark or at a course side of a new mark set upwind of the windward mark. The original windward mark is not a mark of the course for boats required to sail to a finish line set upwind of the original windward mark.
- 12.2 *Leeward Finish:* For a leeward finish, the finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on a RC Boat and the course side of the mark closest to the RC boat. This changes RRS *Rule* 32.2(c).
- 12.3 A boat still racing (i.e., needing additional legs to complete her course) that is inadvertently or prematurely signaled as finishing by RC must continue to race and notify the RC after properly sailing its course. A boat that is prematurely signaled as finishing cannot seek redress, unless RC fails to score the boat. This changes RRS *Rule* 62.1.
- 12.4 If the RC boat is absent when a boat finishes, the boat must report her finishing time/place, and her position in relation to nearby boats, to the RC back at WYC at the first reasonable opportunity.
- **13. RACE TIME LIMITS.** Burton Cup/MS Cup and Commodore Cup races will have a 5-hour time limit. All other races will have a 2-½ hour time limit.

#### 14. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS.

- 14.1 RRS *Rule* 61.1(a)(2) is eliminated. This changes RRS *Rule* 61.1(a)(2).
- 14.2 In addition, a boat protesting another boat will, after finishing, inform (*via* verbal hail and <u>not</u> via radio) the finish-line RC boat what boat(s) is/are being protested. This changes RRS *Rule* 61.
- 14.3 Forms & Protest Time Limit. Protest forms will be available at WYC in front side of Protest Filing Box. Protests and requests for redress or reopening must be delivered to Protest Filing Box within <u>one (1) hour</u> of RC Official Dock Time.
- 14.4 Arbitration. Sections B and D of Appendix T will apply except as follows:
  - 14.4.1 Arbitration meeting of protests alleging RRS Part 2 violations will be scheduled as soon as possible, but not later than 90 minutes after RC Official Dock Time.
  - 14.4.2 Arbitration meeting will <u>only</u> occur on day of race. This changes RRS *Rules* T2 and T5.
  - 14.4.3 The Post-Race Penalty will be calculated as described in RRS *Rule* 44.3(c), but not be less than 2 points (for 20% Post-Race Penalty) and 3 points (for 30% Post-Race Penalty). This changes RRS *Rule* 44.3(c).
  - 14.4.4 No Post-Race Penalty may be taken by a boat for (i) any incident involving damage or injury, or (ii) any incident where a boat gained a significant advantage in the race or series by her breach of a *Rule*. This changes RRS *Rule* T2.2.
  - 14.4.5 Accepting a penalty in arbitration is voluntary and final, and will not be grounds for redress. Once concluded, an arbitration meeting will not be reopened for any reason. When arbitration is unsuccessful or not held, protest will be referred to a protest hearing by the Protest Committee (PC). This changes RRS *Rules* 62.1 and 66.
  - 14.4.6 PC will post date, time and location for a protest hearing on the WYC Official Notice Board no later than 90 minutes from RC dock time.
- 14.5 Protest hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing each day, unless otherwise posted by PC.
- 14.6 Breaches of sailing instructions 16, 18.1 and 18.3 will not be grounds for a protest by a boat. This changes *Rule* 60.1(a). Violation of these sailing instructions may be subject to a lesser penalty, or no penalty, at discretion of the PC. This changes RRS *Rule* 64.1.

#### 15. SCORING.

15.1 As permitted by RRS *Rule* A2, boats may exclude one or more race scores from final series results according to the following table based on the number of races completed in a series:

- 15.2 The first sentence of RRS *Rule* A4.2 is deleted. All races will be scored per *Rule* A9. For purposes of RRS *Rule* A9 (only), the "number of boats entered" will be the greatest total number of boats of a class/division that came to any race of that series or regatta. This changes RRS *Rules* A4.2 and A9.
- 15.3 A boat not finishing within 45 minutes of the first boat in her class to finish, or within the time limit (whichever is later), or by sunset will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing, which will be equal to one point more than the number of boats in her class that do finish within the time limit. The RC will use GPS time for sunset. This changes RRS *Rules* 35, A4, A5 and A9.
- 15.4 For purposes of awarding participation prize, when a race is cancelled or abandoned, boats will be scored "ATT" signifying their attendance. This changes RRS *Rule* A11.
- 15.5 Scoring Inquiries Written Request for Redress. If a boat is not scored or is scored incorrectly for any reason, boat must file a written <u>request for redress</u> in accordance with RRS *Rule* 62, noting "Scoring Inquiry" at the top of the written request.

**16. SAFETY REGULATIONS.** A boat that retires from a race must, as soon as possible, notify the RC *via* hail or VHF radio channel 68 or other competitor channel specified by RC or these SIs.

#### 17. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS. None

#### 18. RADIO AND COMMUNICATIONS.

- 18.1 **All boats are <u>required</u> to carry an operating VHF marine-band radio.** This rule does not apply to lasers, 420s and Optimists. Failure to follow this rule may not be protested by a boat. This changes RRS *Rule* 60.1. Violation of this rule may be subject to a lesser penalty, or no penalty, at discretion of the PC. This changes RRS *Rule* 64.1.
- 18.2 Except in an emergency, while *racing*, boats may only monitor NOAA weather channels and VHF marine radio channel 16, channel 68 and other competitor channels specified by RC or these SIs.
- 18.3 Before, during and after *racing*, RC may (but is not obligated to) hail or make announcements (including without limitation premature starters (OCS), change-of-course, shortening of course and other announcements) on VHF radio channel 68 and any other competitor channel specified by RC or these SIs. Failure or delay to provide announcements will not be grounds for redress under RRS *Rule* 62.1(a).
- 18.4 From the time the RC displays the line flag before the start and until all boats and all classes have finished racing, a boat will not use a VHF radio to make radio transmissions nor receive radio communications not available to all boats except:
  - in an emergency, or
  - when retiring from a race.

From warning signal until boat has finished racing for the day, mobile telephones, tablets, computers and other similar devices may not be used to obtain outside help. For purposes of clarification, boats may carry a GPS unit onboard as permitted in their class rules or for the purpose of recording data for Kattack (but may not access Kattack until ashore). Violation of this rule may be subject to a lesser penalty, or no penalty, at discretion of the PC. This changes RRS *Rule* 64.1.

#### 19. PRIZES.

- 19.1 Prizes will be awarded for each race series or cup race based on the average number of competitors in each fleet/division. One prize for 4 or fewer competitors, two for 5 or 6, three for 7-11, four for 12-15 or 5 for 16 or more average number of competitors.
- 19.2 A participation prize will be awarded to each boat that (i) wins a prize; or (ii) finishes the minimum number of counted races in the Championship Series or the Sunset Series; or (iii) whose number of completed races plus attendance (ATT) points total at least 25 in the races/series listed in SI 19.3 and any other race run by WYC RC for any WYC Class boats on Lake Minnetonka.
- 19.3 The Boat of The Year (BOTY) Prize is awarded to the boat with the most BOTY points for 1st place finishes in the following Series and Cup races: A-B-C-G-T-M, Fall Regatta, plus Burton, Commodore and Frostbite Cups. In addition, BOTY points for Rumbles will be awarded according to Addendum A.2.3. BOTY points are awarded to first place finishers in each qualified race, as follows: 4 points for fleet finishers of 10 or more boats in the race; 3.9 points for 9 boats; 3.7 points for 8 boats; 3 points for 6-7 boats; 2.5 points for 5 boats; 1.9 points for 4 boats; 1.2 points for 3 boats; 0.4 points for 2 boats; and zero (0) points for 1 boat.
- **20. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY AND RELEASE.** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury, including without limitation bodily injury, permanent disability and death. Each person participates in each race entirely at his/her own risk. See RRS *Rule* 4, "Decision to Race".

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY, RACE COMMITTEE, PROTEST COMMITTEE, FLEETS, SPONSORS, WAYZATA SAILING FOUNDATION, WAYZATA COMMUNITY SAILING CENTER, HOST CLUB AND VENUE (AND EACH OF THEIR RESPECTIVE OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, PERSONNEL, EMPLOYEES, CONTRACTORS, OFFICIALS, MEMBERS, GUESTS, VOLUNTEERS, AGENTS, REPRESENTATIVES AND ALL OTHER PERSONS IN THEIR CAPACITY OF ASSISTING A RACE OR RELATED EVENT OR ACTIVITY) (COLLECTIVELY, "RACE ORGANIZERS") WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE OR LIABLE FOR ANY ACTION, CLAIM, LIABILITY, LOSS, DAMAGE, ACCIDENT OR INJURY (INCLUDING BODILY INJURY, PERSONAL INJURY, PERMANENT DISABILITY OR DEATH) TO ANY PERSON, PROPERTY OR BOAT (I) SUSTAINED IN CONJUNCTION WITH OR PRIOR TO, DURING, OR AFTER EACH RACE; OR (II) ARISING, RELATING OR RESULTING FROM USE OF RACE FACILITIES OR PARTICIPATION IN A RACE OR ASSOCIATED EVENT OR ACTIVITY, TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

By participating, each participant (and in the case of children and minors, each participant's parent or guardian) forever releases, discharges and waives any and all actions, suits and claims whatsoever against Race Organizers for any liability, loss, damage and injury (including bodily injury, personal injury, permanent disability and death) to any person, property or boat (i) sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after each race; or (ii) arising, relating or resulting from use of race facilities or participation in a race or associated event or activity, to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Participant further releases all Race Organizers from any claim whatsoever on account of any of them giving assistance, aid, care, advice, rescue, first aid, treatment or services.

- **21. INSURANCE.** Each participating boat will be insured with valid third-party liability insurance not less than amount required by WYC. Each boat will present proof of insurance upon WYC's request.
- **22. PUBLICITY & PHOTOGRAPHER'S RIGHTS.** As a condition of participation, each participant (on behalf of him/herself and their children/minors) grants Organizing Authority, Fleets, sponsors and their designated photographers the perpetual, irrevocable right, license and permission to use, publish and distribute the participant's name, photos, video, images, finishes, results and statements of them and their boat and crew in all forms and media worldwide (including without limitation Internet) for any purposes whatsoever (including without limitation advertisement, promotions, public sale of pictures, etc.) without compensation or further permission.
- **23. ENVIRONMENT:** Per RRS 55, a competitor shall not intentionally put trash in the water.
- **24. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & HOST CLUB.** Organizing Authority and host club is Wayzata Yacht Club located at 1100 Eastman Lane, Wayzata, MN 55391.


# ADDENDUM A RUMBLE ONE DAY REGATTAS ("RUMBLES") RULES

- A1. Unless otherwise posted on WYC Official Notice Board or modified by RC on-the-water per SI #3, the following rules will apply to each Rumble:
- A1.1 Racing area: Wayzata Bay
- A1.2 Start times: See attached Schedule of Races.
- A1.3 Starting Sequence: **Appendix S Sound-Signal Starting System** using **whistles** with the warning given 3 minutes before the *Start* will be used. Per Appendix S2, audible signals will govern, even when visual signals are also used. For Rumbles, flags may, but are not required, to be used. This changes RRS *Rules* 25.3, 26, 27.3, 29, 32, 33 and 34.
- A1.4 Rumbles will use **VHF channel 69**. When practicable, RC will announce *via* radio the course, postponement, starting sequence, recall signals and change(s) of these Rumble rules. Failure or delay to provide announcements will not be grounds for redress under RRS *Rule* 62.1(a).
- A1.6 Marks, including starting mark, will be inflatables of any color and any shape. Offset mark and gate will <u>not</u> be set.
- A1.7 Unless Fleet Captain notifies PRO otherwise prior to first warning signal of Rumble, **up to 7 races** may be sailed.
- A1.8 For Rumble races only, Appendix T1 will apply.
- A1.9 Courses for Rumbles will be either **simple windward-leeward course** or **modified windward-leeward course**. See Illustration B and Illustration D attached hereto.


#### A2. Miscellaneous

- A2.1 No WYC prizes will be awarded for a Rumble.
- A2.2 Attendance Points: Each boat attending a Rumble will receive one-half (0.5) attendance point for each race attended. If an odd number of races are held resulting in X.5, the number of attendance points will be rounded up. A minimum of one (1) attendance point will be awarded for each boat attending that day.
- A2.3 BOTY Points: For purposes of BOTY Prize, each Rumble will constitute 1 qualified race counted towards BOTY Prize, the same as each general WYC race scheduled to be sailed on the main lake. The boat with the most first (1<sup>st</sup>) place finishes of each Rumble will be awarded all the BOTY points per the last sentence of SI 19.3. Ties will be broken according to RRS *Rule* A8. For purposes of awarding BOTY points for each Rumble, 'fleet finishers' or 'number of boats entered' will be the sum of the number of finishers divided by the number of races rounded to the nearest whole number (0.5 to be rounded upward).
- A2.4 For a Rumble, to the extent a rule in this Addendum A conflicts with a rule in WYC SI, Addendum A will apply.
